# What's Available at AWC?

- \* Lodging for up to 150 guests in our camper and staff cabins. Two of our camper cabins and our nine staff cabins (which together lodge a total of 73 people) can be heated when needed. Please see lodging for further cabin descriptions.
- \* Miles of beautiful trails, forests, and lakes are yours to enjoy.
- \* Use of our camp lake and sports equipment. You can swim, canoe, kayak, paddle board, fish, play soccer, shoot hoops, and play tennis. You can hike or bike around camp or choose to head out for a climb up Bald Mountain down the road for a great view of the Fulton Chain of Lakes. Come back to Woodcraft to play ping pong, set up a game of corn hole, relax at the beach, chat around the campfire... there are so many activities for you and your guests to choose from. Adventure activities like archery, rock climbing, and zip lining come at an extra cost due to safety requirements and staffing needs. Please inquire with us if you would like to schedule a 2 hour time bracket for an adventure activity.
- \* The Long House: Classic Adirondack charm with big beams, a sunken fireplace with seating around it, beautiful wood floors with shuffle board and giant checkers, a stage and a ping-pong room. The Long House has been the site of group meetings and presentations, rehearsal dinners, indoor wedding ceremonies and after-hours campfire gatherings. You can't help but love the Long House.
- \* The Dining Hall: High beam ceilings, plenty of light through old-fashioned windows, hand-hammered copper lights that create a warm glow, a reinforced wood floor for dancing, and two large stone fireplaces at either end of the room. Perfect for meals, meetings, and celebrations of any kind. It's charming on its own and you can add your own decor if you like. Many great events come together here. There are tables and chairs for up to 150 guests. The dining hall can seat up to 200 people, you would just need to bring in extra tables and chairs.
- \* The Field of Dreams: A wide open field with a barn to the side and a small mountain as its backdrop, "Field O" is home to soccer games and as a cross through on trails for biking, hiking & cross country skiing. The Field of Dreams has also help many wedding ceremonies. It's a special spot!
- \* The Camp Docks: If you love being by the water, you'll love our docks and enjoying views of peaceful lakes and tree-rimmed horizons.
- \* The Campfire Circle: Enjoy the beauty of this intimate space among the pines and Tamaracks with wooden benches already set up for you.

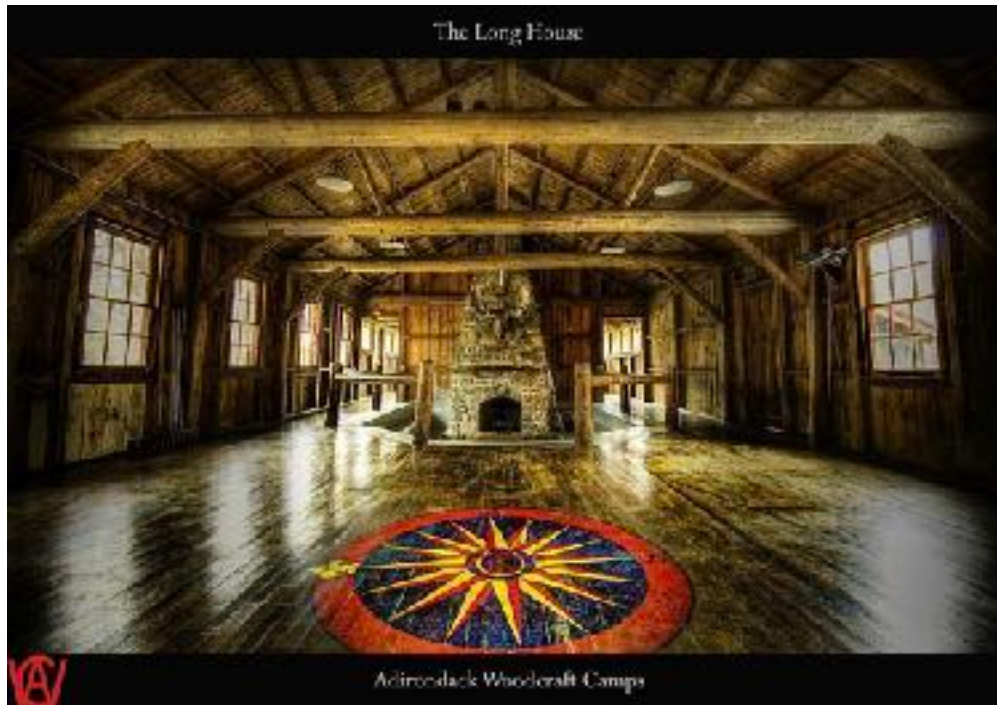

# Lodging

Lodging for up to 150 guests in the cabins described below. A sheet set, pillow, fleece blanket and a towel is also included is available for rent for \$25/person/weekend. Bring sleeping bags or warmer blankets in addition for cooler nights!



## **Hadarondah Cabin (Sleeps up to 20)**

The Hadarondah Cabin sleeps 20 between 2 large camper rooms with cots, 2 separate bedrooms with two twins and one separate bedroom with a queen bed. This cabin has heat when needed and features one bathroom with shower in the front room and two full bathrooms with showers in the back room.



## Outpost Cabin (Sleeps up to 20)

The Outpost Cabin sleeps 20 between its two large camper rooms that share bathrooms and showers and one counselor room with a full bed that has its own small bathroom and shower. The Outpost also has heat when needed and features a rustic living room area.



## **Deerhead (Sleeps up to 4)**

The Deerhead Cabin is a charming duplex cabin with two private bedrooms and attached bathrooms. Each bedroom has a queen bed. Heat is available.



## **Tamarack Cabin (Sleeps up to 4)**

The Tamarack Cabin is cozy and inviting with one queen bedroom, a sitting room with a full sized futon, a kitchenette, and a bathroom with shower and tub. This cabin has heat when needed and features a great porch for sitting outside.



## **Birch, Hemlock, Red Fox, Black Bear & Little Moose Cabins (Sleeps up to 16 total)**

Our **Birch & Hemlock** cabins are cozy and private. They each have a queen bedroom, sitting room, and a bathroom. Birch has a twin bed and a queen bed in the bedroom and Hemlock has a queen bed in the bedroom and a pull out sofa in the living room.

**Red Fox & Black Bear** cabins have a large sitting room with a twin bed and a bedroom with a queen bed each. These cabins share a rustic bathroom outside of the cabin.

**Little Moose** Cabin has a queen bedroom and a large living room with a futon.





## **Sugar Maple & Spruce Cabins (Sleeps up to 6)**

These two simple but charming cabins are by our lake and share a private bathroom and shower next door. They have heat when needed. Sugar Maple has one full bed and one queen bed while the Spruce has two queen beds.



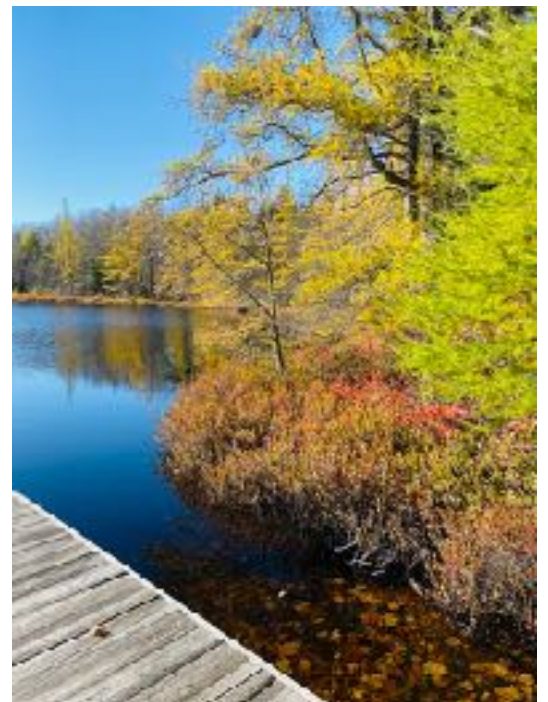
## Iriquois Village, Ranger, and Tejecna Lodging

Adirondack Woodcraft Camps has 13 more camper cabins that feature one large room for group style accommodations for up to 8 with shared bathrooms and showers close-by. These cabins have lights and electric outlets but do not have heat. (Unfortunately, using space heaters is not possible as the cabins are screened in only.)



## Trail Camp

Trail Camp is a special spot on camp with beautiful views, it's own dock and fire pit and classic Adirondack style lean-to lodging. Each lean to has two cots. Lean-to guests can use the shared bathhouse at Trail Camp for bathroom and shower needs.

# What's Expected

- Care and respect for our beautiful and well-loved property, buildings and equipment.
- Please note that we require a \$1 million general liability and liquor liability insurance (if needed.) to make sure you are covered in case of any incidents. Please name Adirondack Woodcraft Camps and Bartlett Pines, Inc. as additionally insured.
- We take care of cleaning and sanitizing all buildings but we expect you and your caterers to return camp to us the way you found it: tidy and cared for.
- Please drive carefully and slowly as you drive in to camp. One of the things that makes Woodcraft special is that we care for it as if it's our home... because it is! We live on camp year-round with our three children and dog, Sunny.
- All swimmers must follow Woodcraft swimming guidelines. All boaters and paddle boarders must wear life jackets.
- Any activity in or on the water must take place between dawn and dusk.
- Campfires may only be held in fire circles.
- No smoking in any buildings. Smoking is limited to outside of the dining hall where receptacles can be found. All cigarette butts must be thrown in receptacles and not on the ground.
- Cars must park in the camp parking lots. Exceptions are made for shuttling guests who need assistance. No parking on fields or grass.
- We do not have a set curfew, but ask that loud music be finished playing by midnight out of courtesy for neighbors around Woodcraft. Thank you!
- Events hosting more than 150 guests in the dining hall must provide a port-a-potty option. We do not want sewer problem to put a damper on your special event!
